A) Privacy policy

Data collection on our website

1. Who is responsible for data collection on this website?

Chapter 1:

Principle

Right to data portability

SSL or TLS encryption

Chapter 2: Data collection on our website

Cookies

Our website uses cookies. Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain any viruses. Cookies help make our website more user-friendly, efficient, and secure. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called "session cookies". They are automatically deleted after your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. These cookies make it possible to recognize your browser when you next visit the site.

You can configure your browser to inform you about the use of cookies so that you can decide on a case-by-case basis whether to accept or reject a cookie. Alternatively, your browser can be configured to automatically accept cookies under certain conditions or to always reject them, or to automatically delete cookies when closing your browser. Contact form or enquiry via Lab-Finder

Should you send us enquiries via the contact form or via Lab-Finder, we will collect and store the data entered in the enquiry form, including the contact data you provided, for the purpose of processing the enquiry and to answer any follow-up questions. We do not share this data without your consent. The processing of the data entered in the contact form or in Lab-Finder is therefore carried out exclusively on the basis of your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 sub-para (a) of the GDPR). You may revoke your consent at any time. An informal email making this request is sufficient. The data processed before we receive your request may still be legally processed. We will retain the data you provide on the contact form or in Lab-Finder until you request its deletion, revoke your consent for its storage, or the purpose for its storage no longer pertain (e.g. after your enquiry has been processed). Mandatory statutory provisions, in particular retention periods, remain unaffected.

Registration on this website

You can register as a member on our website to use additional features offered here. The input data will only be used for the purpose of using the respective site or service for which you have registered. The mandatory information requested during registration must be provided in full. Otherwise we will decline the registration.

To inform you about important changes, in particular for technically necessary changes, we will use the e-mail address specified during registration.

We will process the data provided during registration only based on your consent per Art. 6 para. 1 sub-para (a) of the GDPR. You may revoke your consent at any time. An informal email making this request is sufficient. The data processed before we receive your request may still be legally processed.

We will store the data collected during registration as long as you are registered on our website. Thereafter, it will be deleted. Statutory retention periods remain unaffected.

Processing of data (member and contract data)

We collect, process and use personal data only to the extent necessary to substantiate, structure the content or amend a contract or to fulfil our obligations towards you as a member (inventory data). This is done on the basis of Art. 6 para. 1 sub-para (b) of the GDPR, which permits the processing of data for the fulfilment of a contract or pre-contractual measures. We collect, process and use personal data about the use of our internet pages (usage data) only to the extent necessary to enable the user to make use of the service or for billing purposes. The collected customer data will be deleted after completion of the order or termination of the business relationship. Statutory retention periods remain unaffected.

Data transmission at contract conclusion for dispatch of goods and payment transactions
